Today's Liturgy

Gospel: John Paul Heil Main
Theme: Jesus promises us the
HOLY SPIRIT and PEACE.

In his farewell discourse in the Gospel of John Jesus promises that after his death and resurrection the Father will send us the Holy Spirit in his name. Indeed, the death and resurrection of Jesus made possible this gift of the Spirit. Out of the pierced side of the crucified Jesus flowed blood and water (19:34), symbolizing the life-giving Spirit that comes from his death. And the risen Jesus "breathed" the Spirit into the disciples with the words, "Receive the Holy Spirit" (20:22).

This Holy Spirit, who will teach and remind us of everything that Jesus told us, is instrumental in bringing about the peace that Jesus promises to give us. It is not the peace that the world gives, which is often merely the absence of warfare or conflict, illusory, and transitory. Rather, Jesus promises us God's peace, a permanent and complete well-being and harmony with God and with one another. It is the Spirit of forgiveness (20:22-23) given by the risen Jesus that makes this peace possible. Let us rejoice that by going to the Father through his death and resurrection Jesus is able to give us these great gifts of the Holy Spirit and lasting peace.

MYSTAGOGY: Mystagogy is reflecting. It is a time set aside for those who just celebrated the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil to share the meaning of the rites and rituals they just celebrated. Perhaps sharing how our experience affected us is something that we do not do often enough. We need to take some time to reflect, perhaps with others, on the meaning of the Holy Week celebrations. We are so used to looking forward to upcoming events that we forget how important it is to look back and share how and where God touched our hearts. That is the whole meaning of Mystagogy. To ask the question after every Sunday Eucharist, "Where did God touch me during the Liturgy?" would be a wonderful way to make more real the power of God's presence.

Liturgia de hoy

Evangelio: John Paul Heil Tema principal: Jesús nos promete el ESPÍRITU SANTO y la PAZ.

En su discurso de despedida en el Evangelio de Juan, Jesús promete que después de su muerte y resurrección, el Padre nos enviará el Espíritu Santo en su nombre. De hecho, la muerte y resurrección de Jesús hicieron posible este don del Espíritu. Del lado perforado del crucificado, Jesús fluyó sangre y agua (19:34), simbolizando el Espíritu vivificante que proviene de su muerte. Y el Jesús resucitado "insufló" el Espíritu en los discípulos con las palabras: "Recibe el Espíritu Santo" (20:22).

Este Espíritu Santo, que nos enseñará y nos recordará todo lo que Jesús nos dijo, es fundamental para lograr la paz que Jesús promete darnos. No es la paz que da el mundo, que a menudo es simplemente la ausencia de guerra o conflicto, ilusoria y transitoria. Más bien, Jesús nos promete la paz de Dios, un bienestar y armonía permanentes y completos con Dios y entre nosotros. Es el Espíritu de perdón (20: 22-23) dado por Jesús resucitado lo que hace posible esta paz. Regocijémonos de que al ir al Padre a través de su muerte y resurrección, Jesús puede darnos estos grandes dones del Espíritu Santo y la paz duradera.
