## Today's Liturgy

Celebration Summary: Bryan M. Cones The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as "Good Shepherd Sunday" in reference to the Gospel of the day—always a passage from John chapter 10—in which Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd. This year the Gospel focuses on the unity of Christ and the Father, who are one in their love and care for the sheep. The other two readings focus on the sheep, emphasizing especially the diversity of the flock: "a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue" (second reading). The rest of the liturgy fleshes out this image. Christ the shepherd leads us in our journey to heaven (collect).

Today's liturgy must proclaim the whole mystery of the Good Shepherd, which is rooted in the mystery of the Trinity, and of the flock, one people of many nations and races. Since today is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations to Church ministry, the community would do well to pray those who embody the Shepherd's care: ordained ministers, religious women and men, and lay ministers, both those currently serving and those to come. Don't forget the other "shepherds" as well: parents, health care workers, teachers, and so on.

## Liturgia de hoy

Resumen de la celebración: Bryan M. Cones El cuarto domingo de Pascua se conoce tradicionalmente como el "domingo del Buen Pastor" en referencia al Evangelio del día, siempre un pasaje de Juan capítulo 10, en el que Jesús se describe a sí mismo como el Buen Pastor. Este año, el Evangelio se centra en la unidad de Cristo y el Padre, quienes son uno en su amor y cuidado por las ovejas. Las otras dos lecturas se centran en las ovejas, destacando especialmente la diversidad del rebaño: "una gran multitud, que nadie podría contar, de todas las naciones, razas, personas y lenguas" (segunda lectura). El resto de la liturgia arroja esta imagen. Cristo, el pastor, nos guía en nuestro viaje al cielo (colecta).

La liturgia de hoy debe proclamar todo el misterio del Buen Pastor, que está enraizado en el misterio de la Trinidad y del rebaño, un pueblo de muchas naciones y razas. Dado que hoy es también el Día Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones al ministerio de la Iglesia, la comunidad haría bien en rezar a quienes encarnan el cuidado de Shepherd: ministros ordenados, religiosos y religiosas, y ministros laicos, tanto los que están sirviendo como los que están por venir. No se olvide también de los otros "pastores": padres, trabajadores de la salud, maestros, etc.

**THE 50 DAYS OF EASTER:** The 50 days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated in joyful exultation as are feast days, or better as one "Great Sunday."

**MOTHER'S DAY:** Frequently Mother's Day falls on the same date as Good Shepherd Sunday. The Gospel for that day tells us of the love that the Good Shepherd has for the Sheep. This image fits well with that of Mother's Day. The imagery comes from the Book of Psalms where God is compared to a nurturing Mother. The refrain has a beautiful melody and even more beautiful words. Can you picture yourself being cradled in the arms of God? God, our Shepherd, God our Mother wants to hold us close and love us with an everlasting love.

## Meals for Walnut Park Emergency Shelter

Donations given at our annual auction support our outreach programs including our Food Pantry, emergency assistance for utilities and rent, as well as "Meals for Walnut Park." St Andrew parishioners have cooked a high protein, nutritious meal for 80 residents living in this new shelter each Monday since the beginning of February. In total, we prepared 1,040 meals. The cost of our signature meal "Chili Mac and Green Salad" is \$77, less than \$1.00 per person. A girl scout troop, the AACCO, and a parishioner's girlfriend group also used our kitchen to prepare meals for Walnut Park residents. This temporary winter shelter will stay open through May and possibly longer. If you are interested in helping cook or shop please contact the Community Center Director, Lisa Hatten.
